

Spring has finally arrived and work has been begun with no signs that it will slow down through the rest of the year. We are in need of more essential workers who can professionally perform our craft. If you are aware of any workers that can handle a trowel, please have them contact the local or use the QR code below. If you are out of work, please let us know so we can place you on the out of work list.

Local 2 has brought in over 40 new apprentices so far this year that are finishing up training and we have identified contractors that they will be placed with. We are still recruiting workers from our marketing program and our social media platforms, in order to fill the needs of our employers. In July we will enter into the last year of the Building, Heavy Highway and Tile agreements, therefore, negotiations will start next spring.

We have many projects the Local 2 Jurisdiction, such as, the OGS PLA projects, SUNY NFR building, Eastern Approach Capital Steps, Turning Stone Casino, and one of the biggest PLA in the country MICRON chip plant in Clay, NY near Syracuse. Recently, I had the opportunity to meet the principal owners of MICRON and they relayed to us the amount of people needed for this project. It will require many contractors to bid the work and our members working on the project. They are projected to start this summer and masons will be working there by years end into all of 2026. We have started our specialized training for the project. If you would like more information about the training, please contact our training department.
